It is a pleasure for me to offer this letter of support for Java Kitrick and her nomination for the GCAC Community Arts Partner Award.

Ms. Kitrick and her leadership of the Puffin Foundation have served as a significant support to the arts in the Greater Columbus community for many years. Columbus Dance Theatre has been the recipient of two grant awards from The Puffin Foundation as well as personal contributions from Ms. Kitrick. As well, through Puffin and through personal contributions, Ms Kitrick has offered support to numerous arts organizations and individual artists including: The Wexner Center for the Arts and The Ohio State University Department of Dance, artist Eva Andry's Putting Names to Faces project, The Short Stop Youth Center, and the *Eyes Wide Open* project among many others.

Columbus Dance Theatre received much needed support from the Puffin Foundation and Ms. Kitrick in 2007 for its project *Peace*. This project brought together multiple arts and cultural organizations including: The Carpe Diem String Quartet, Thurber House, and the Chancel Choir of First Community Church. Last Season CDT's production of *Courage* benefitted from a dramatic level of support from Ms. Kitrick not only through funding from Puffin Foundation West LTD. but through the partnership that she facilitated between CDT and the ACLU of Ohio.
